Terms of Use /Climbing Forest Aachen 2012

Before entering the high-ropes courses every participant/user has to read the terms of use. By signing the list, you certify that you understood and accept the terms of use without further disregard. The custodians of under aged participants are solely responsible for the supervision and escort of the minors during the visit of the high-ropes courses. With their signature the custodians confirm that they internalized the terms of use with the minors and that they are solely responsible for them in the park.

With his signature every visitor agrees that pictures taken during his adventure in the forest may be used for the purposes of the high-ropes course aachen/climbing forest Aachen- KletterAixperten GmbH (if you do not want your pictures to be used commercialy please inform one of our employees).

The prices as listed on the bulletin are valid.

Conditions

The high-ropes course/climbing forest is open to visitors with a reaching height of 140cm who do not suffer from a psychological or physical impairment that might endanger themselves or others while in the park. Persons with a bodyweight in excess of a 120kg are not allowed in the climbing park.

Children under eleven years have to be accompanied by an adult while climbing at all times; a maximum of three children per companion/adult is allowed (Group arrangements on request). Persons under the influence of drugs or alcohol are not permitted to enter the climbing site.

Safety regulations

Every participant has to follow the safety briefing given by the guides. All instructions of the supervisor are binding. In the course two carabiners have to be clipped to the safety cable at all times. During carabiner transfer one carabiner has to stay clipped to the safety cable. If uncertain with the use please seek out a supervisor for your help/assistance immediately!

While belaying one hand is used for holding oneself, the other hand transfers the carabiners. On cableways/slides the trolley has to be placed behind the carabiners additionally. Before sliding please make sure that no person is blocking the arrival area! The legs should be extended in sliding direction. Sometimes slowing down is necessary, in this case one hand has to be pressed against the steel cable behind the trolley to slow down. Only one adult is allowed in an obstacle. The platforms may be used by a maximum of three adults at the same time.

The supervisor team has the right to exclude guests from the park, who do not follow the terms of use and to close the business in case of force majeure (Fire, Storm, Thunderstorm, etc.). In such cases there will be no monetary reimbursement.

Long hair should be stowed with hair ties or with a baseball cap.

It is not allowed to take any items up in the trees that might pose a risk for the participant or for visitors on the ground (Photo camera, Watch, Jewelry, backpack, Cell phone, etc.).

If you are wearing a harness, smoking is strictly forbidden. In the forest area as well as on the premises of Maria im Tann smoking is also strictly forbidden.

Equipment

The equipment belongs to the high-ropes course Aachen/climbing forest Aachen (two carabiners connected by a lanyard, cable trolley, harness) and is lent to the participant at admission cost for the duration of the visit (= 150 minutes). Leaving the premises with the equipment (including the premises of Maria im Tann, excluding kiosk and restrooms) is not allowed. Equipment damages must directly be reported to the supervisor staff. The participant confirms the receipt of all equipment.

Exceeding the time limit will lead to an additional payment of 2,00 Euro per half hour. Every participant cares for his own equipment and has to hand it back after 2,5 hours. The equipment may not be altered or abstracted.

Accountability

The entry to the site and the premises is on your own risk. The park operator is only liable for material damages and pecuniary loss (financial damages), if the personnel acts with gross negligence.

The high-ropes course Aachen/climbing forest Aachen- Tivoli Rock GmbH is not accountable in case of damages or accidents that result from disobeying the terms of use or false statements. We are not accountable for the storage of personal items.

And also few short notes:

You are just now entering a forest, a living eco-system with numerous animals. Closed shoes (no high heels ;-)) or flip flops) are necessary as roots and blackberries can be found along the trails. It is possible that your clothing will get dirty. In this case, we are not accountable for dirty or damaged clothing.

We understand that we are guests in the forest, a prestine eco-system and we would like our guests to act accordingly, therefore the following game rules are in effect:

Rules of the Game

- We try to avoid waste and if we find waste, we take it with us and throw it in one of the trash cans
- We stay on the designated trails (Trainer/Coaches are allowed to leave those trails to guarantee the security of our guests)
- We do not eradicate plants
- We do not harm any trees on purpose
- We do not smoke in the forest
- Dogs stay on the leash and owners dispose their dogs business themselves
